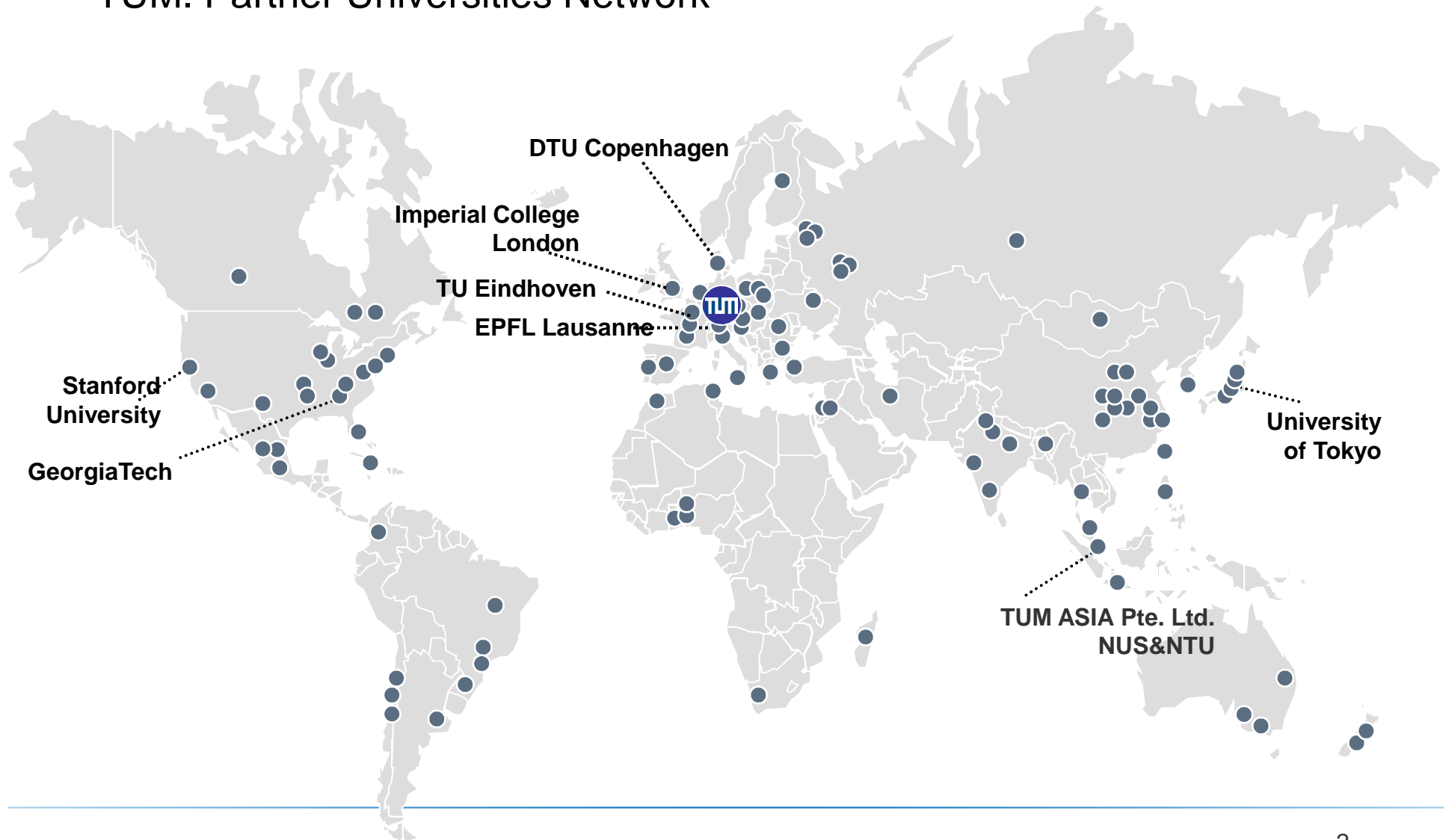

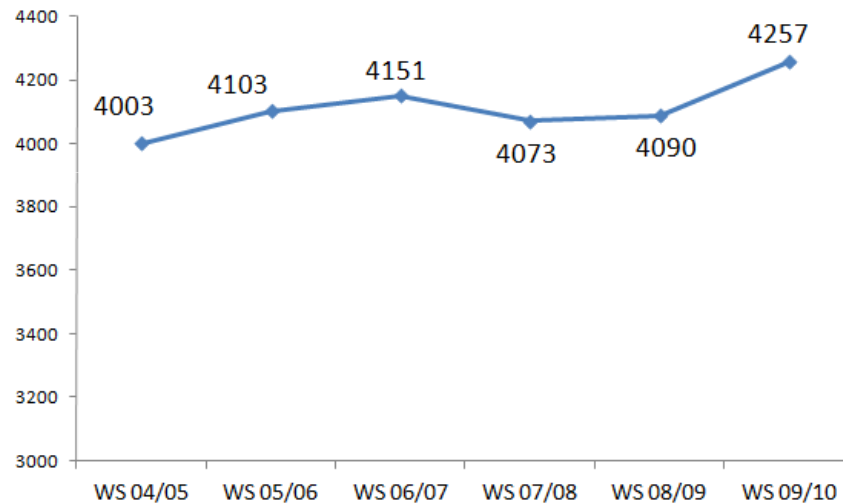

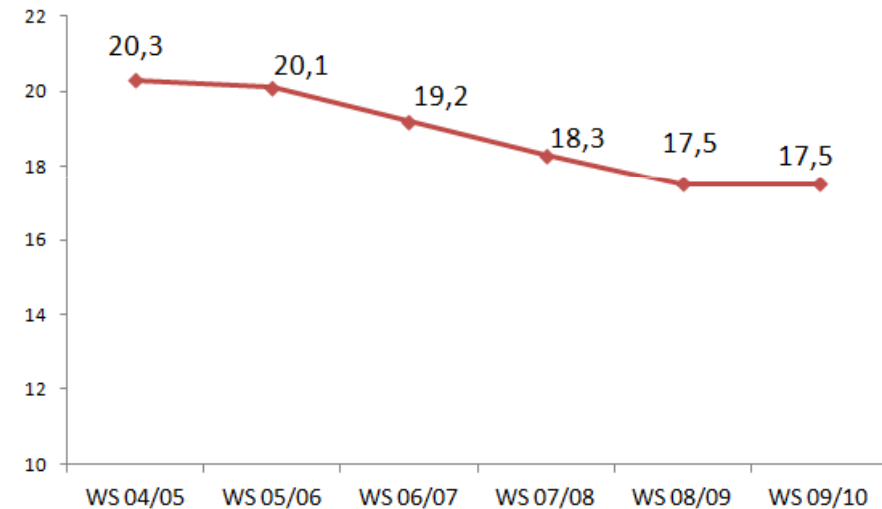


Internationale Studierende (2004-2009)

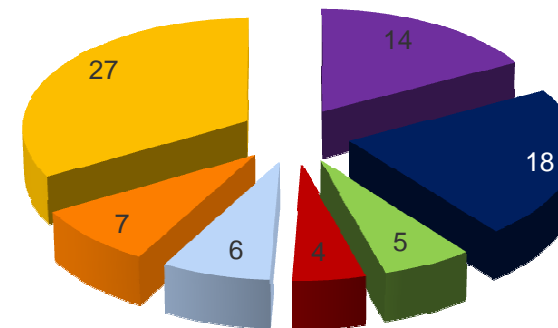
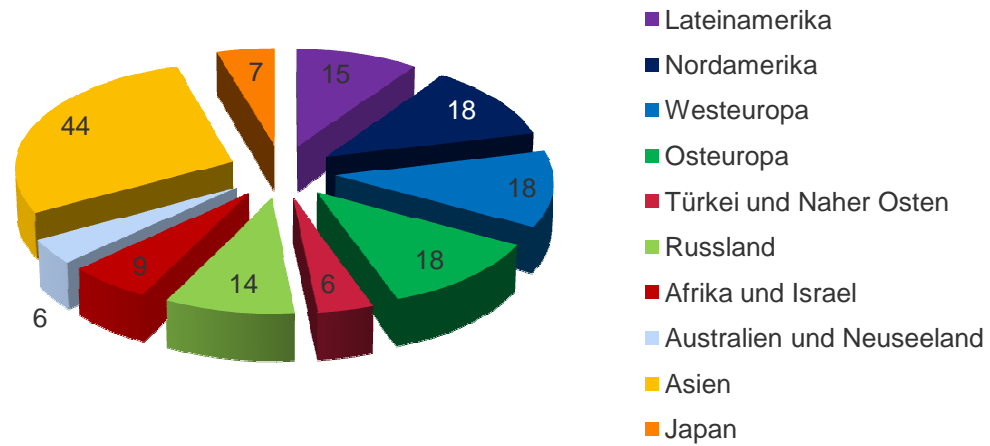


Anstieg des Anteils von Bildungsinländern im WS 2009/10 auf ca. 16% (n= 696)!

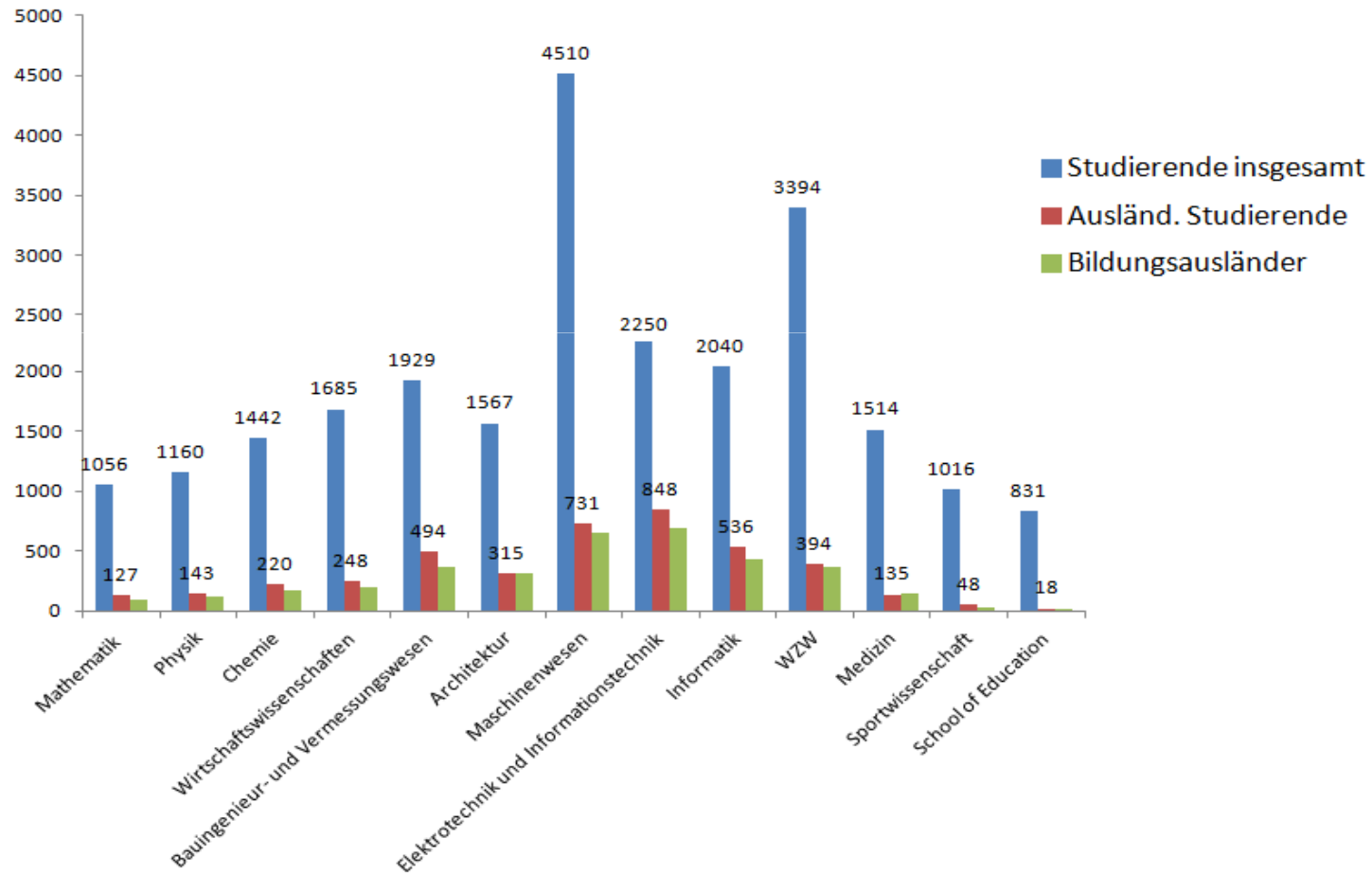

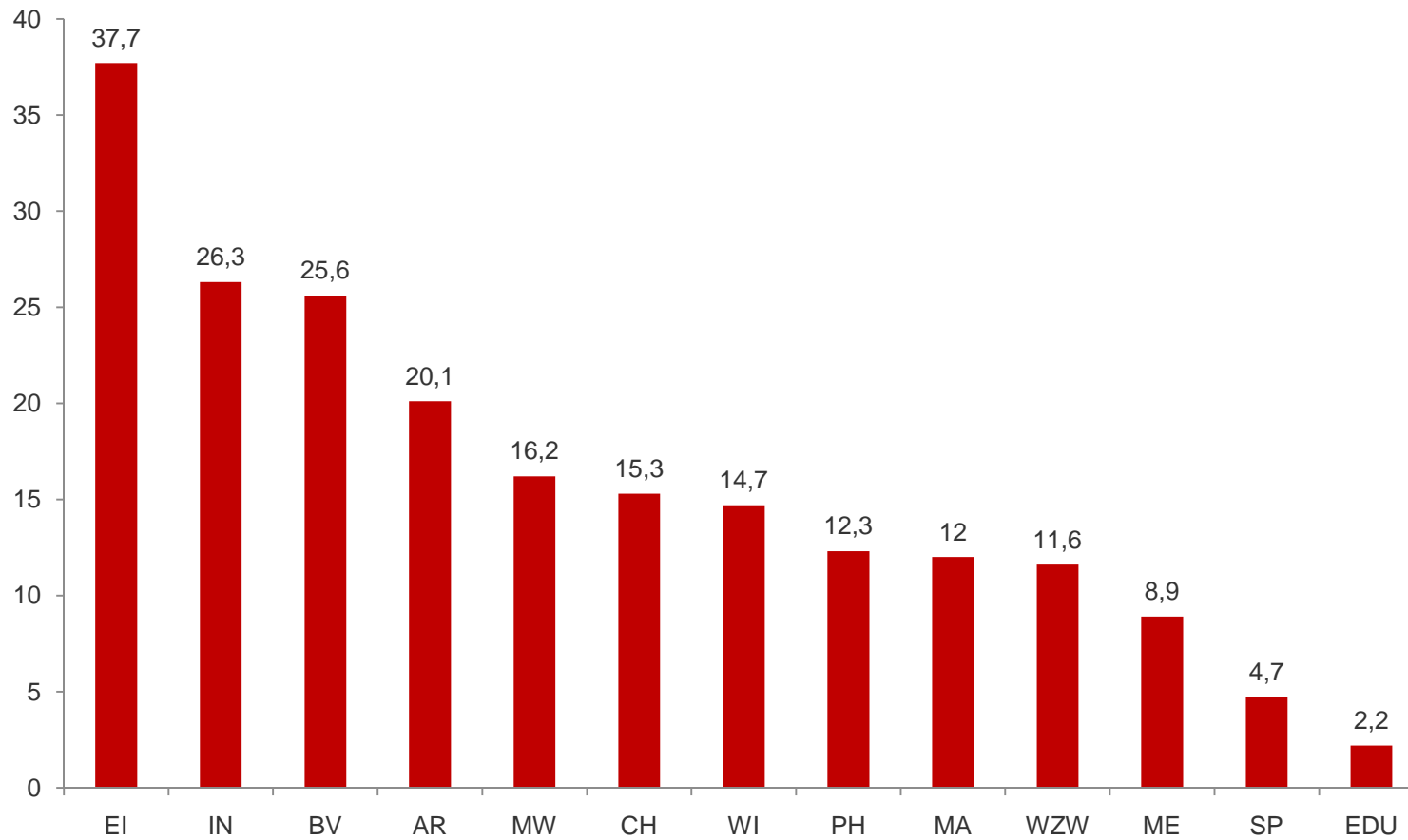

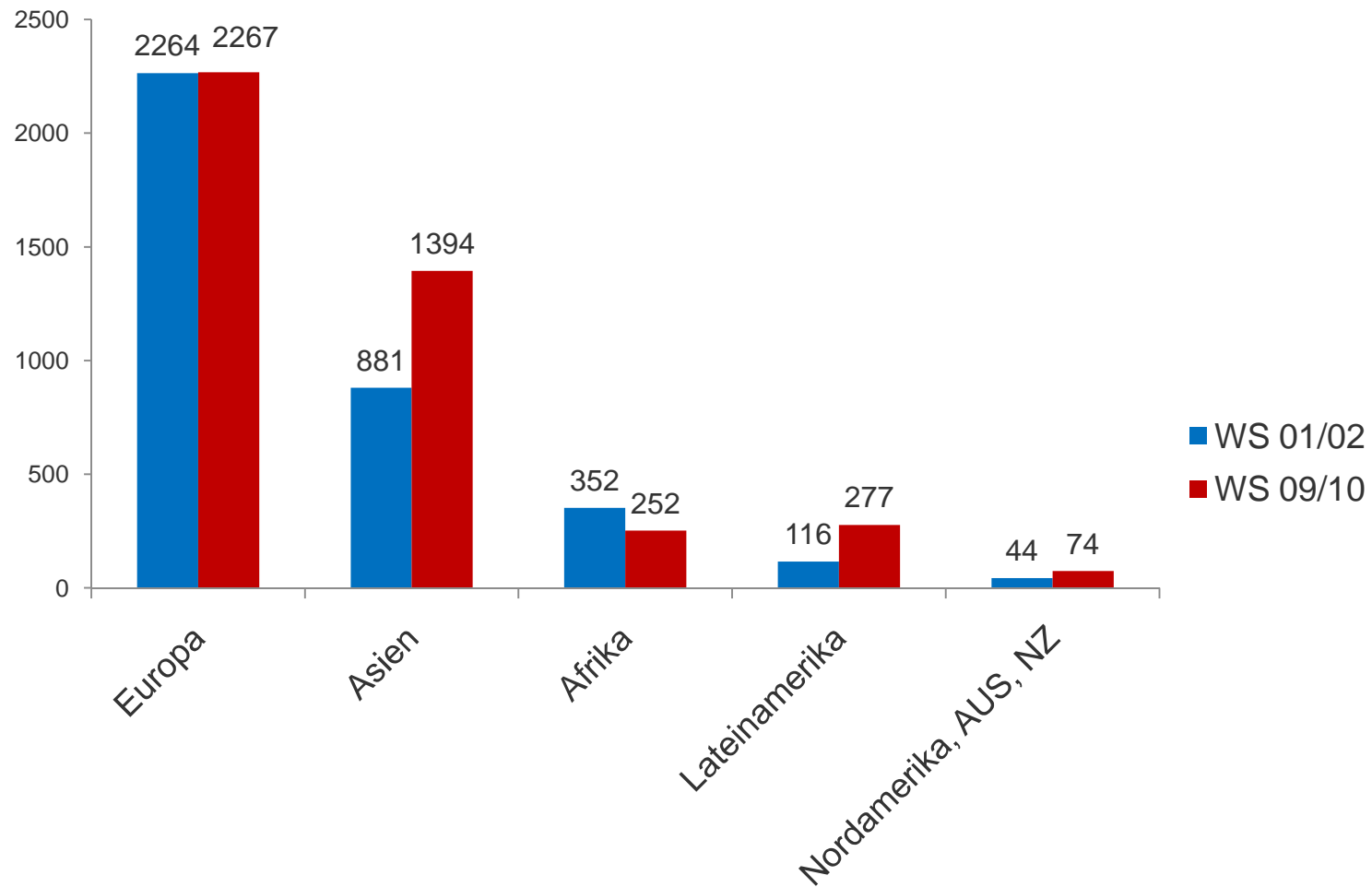
(Int.) Studierende nach Fakultäten (WS 2009/10)



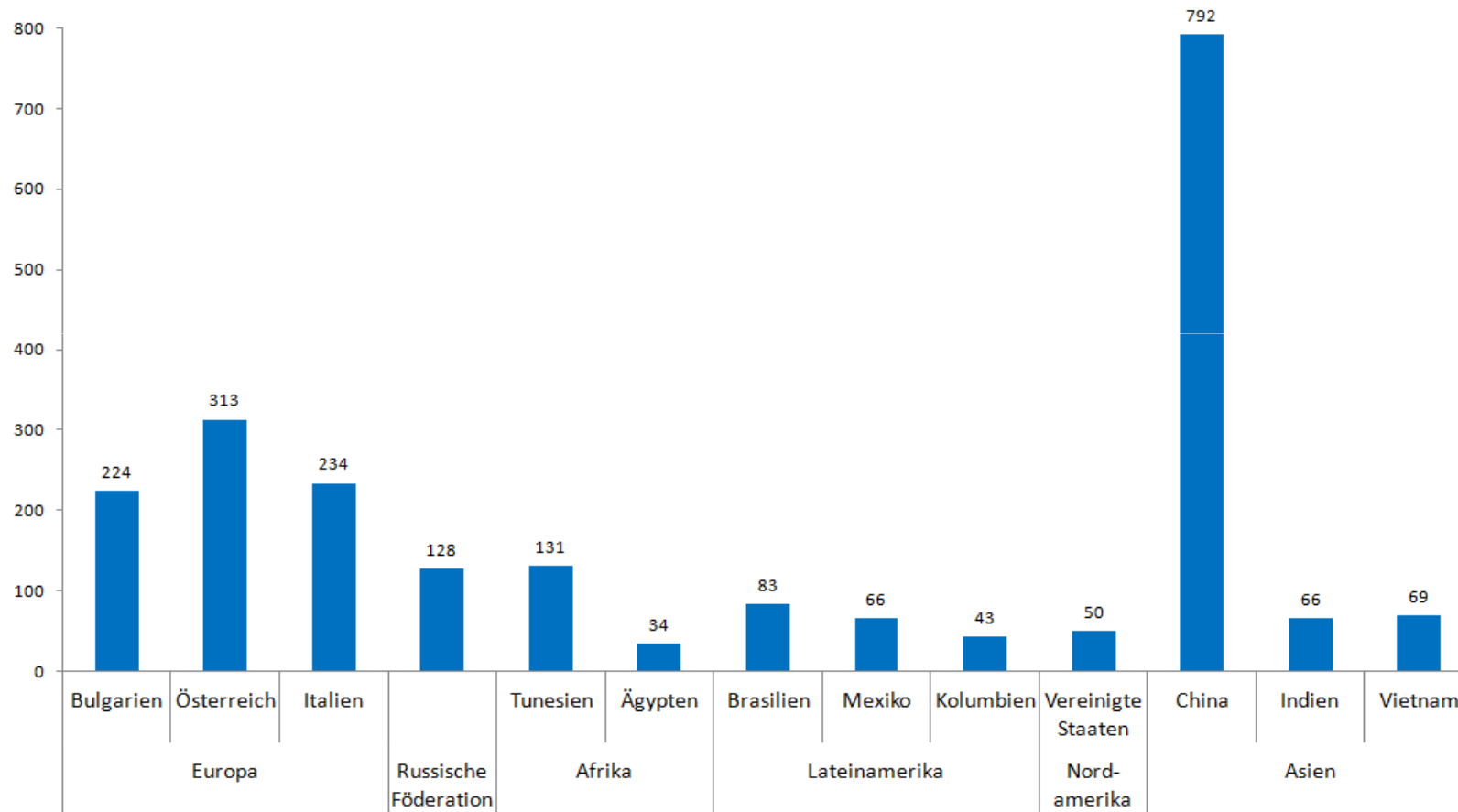
Quote int. Studierender nach Fakultäten (WS 2009/10)



Int. Studierende nach Herkunftsregion (2001 x 2009)

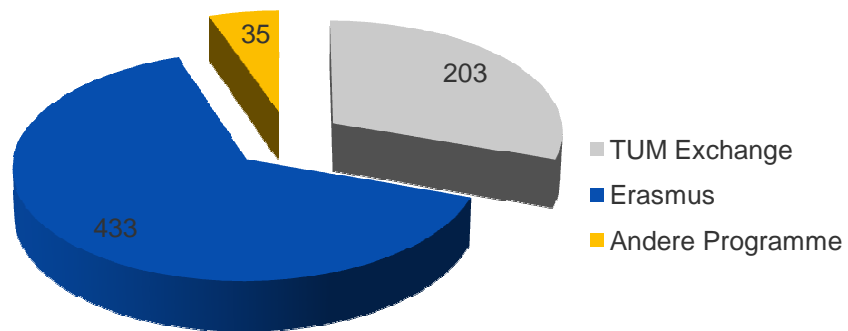


Wichtige Herkunftsländer int. Studierender (WS 2009/10)

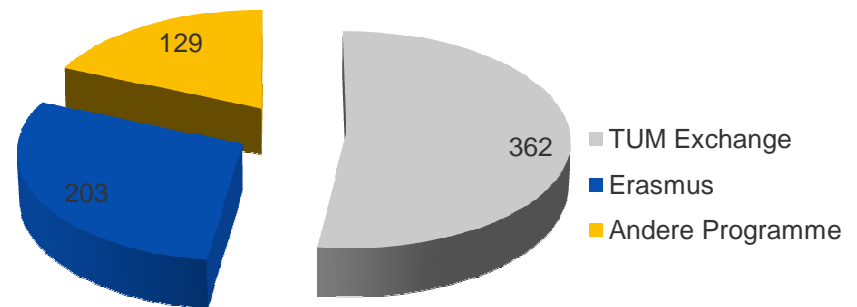

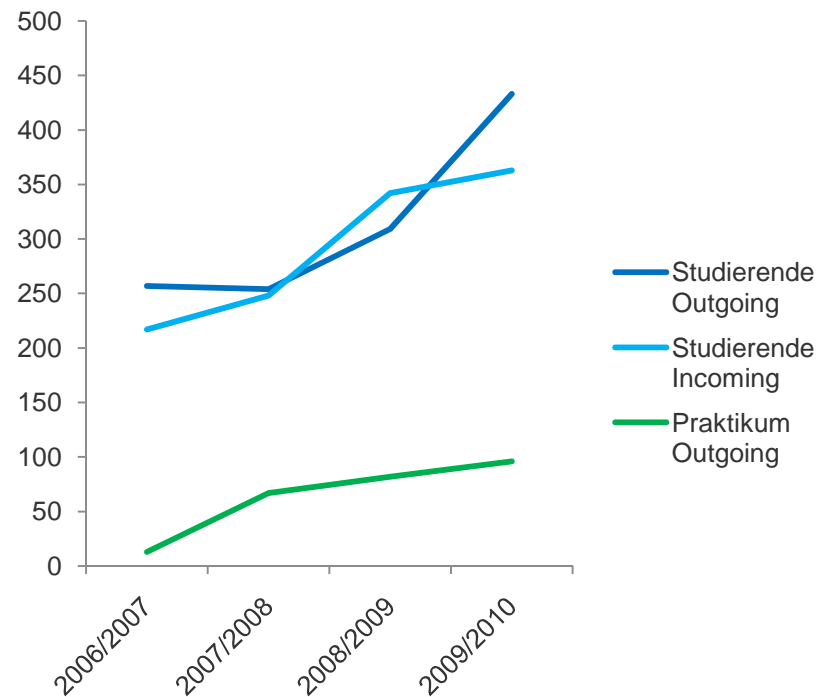
Total incomings



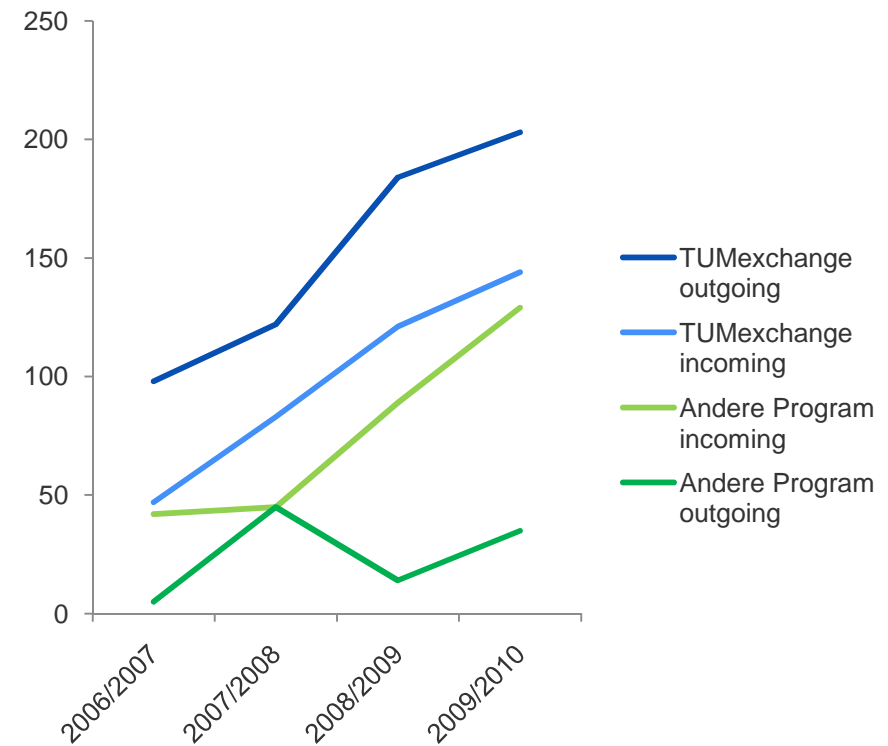
Total outgoings



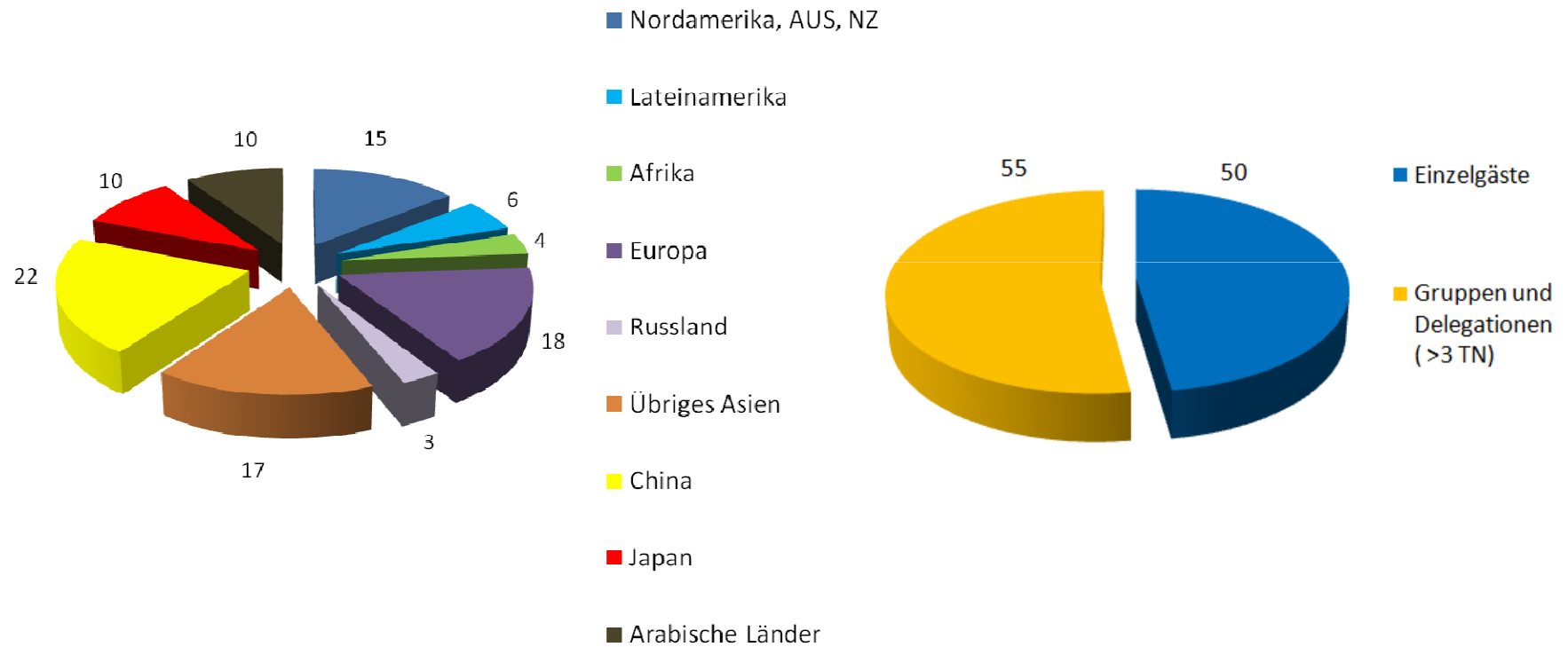
ERASMUS outgoing- und incoming-Mobilität (2006-2009)



TUMexchange outgoing- und incoming-Mobilität (2006-2009)

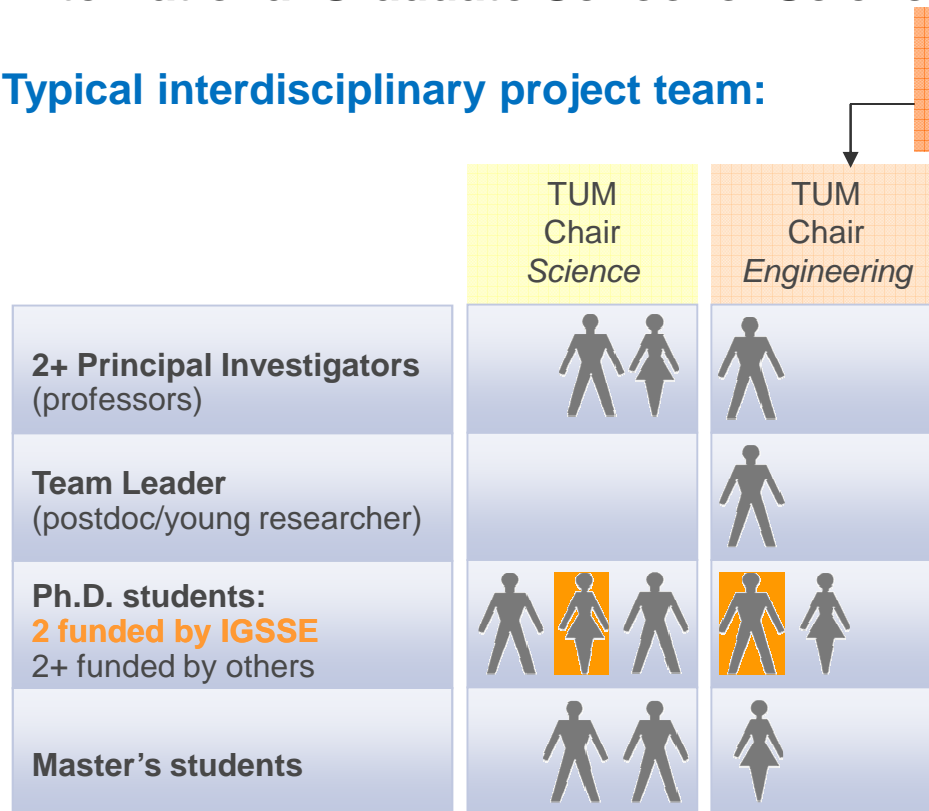

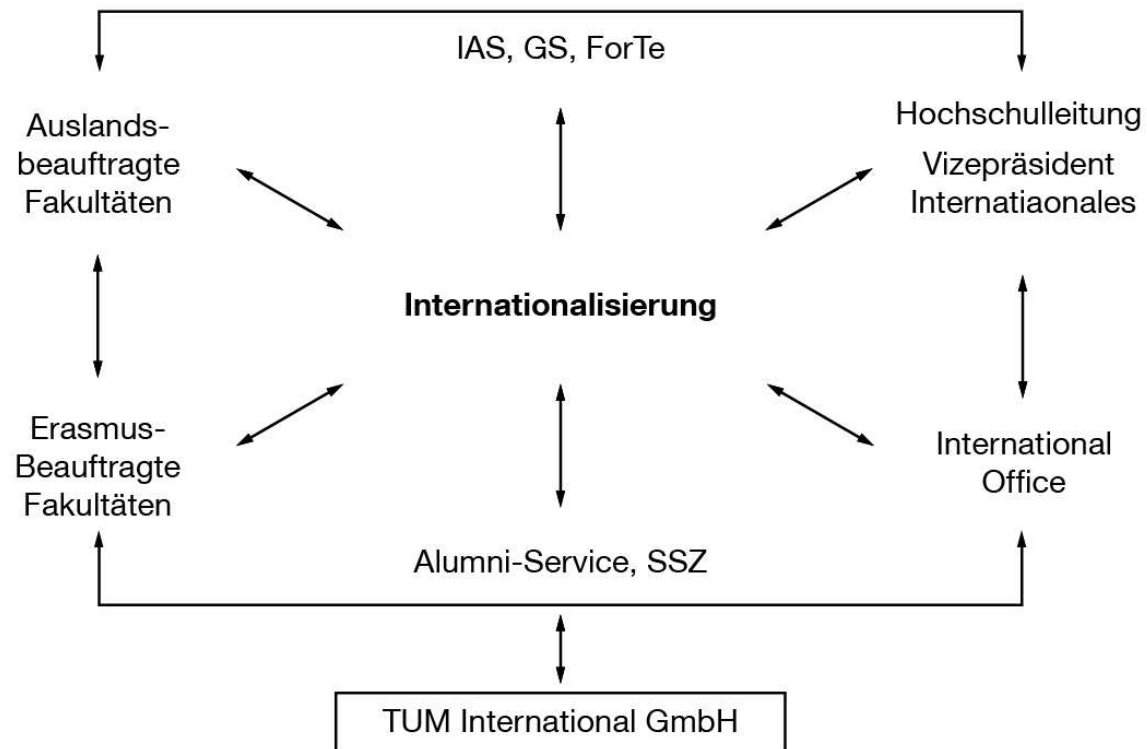
